**AS WE GATHER...** We hear many voices in our society, today, about all aspects of our lives. Whether it is about what we eat, what we wear, what we watch, or what we say, there are social norms that our culture proposes. This weekend we hear from the prophet Isaiah that the people turned God's word upside down. In Ephesians, Paul sets out God's plan for marriage—the topic for our sermon. In the Gospel, Jesus condemns the Jewish leaders for following their own traditions rather than God's Word. How do we live in a world which does not want to live according to God's Word? Do we know God's Word sufficiently to follow Him?

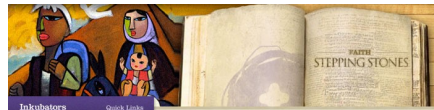
