
## >>> UNIT TWO <<<



## EVERY GENERATION FAITHFUL TOGETHER UPDATE



Our ministry expansion project is steadily moving forward. In the last month, the committees reported the following progress:

## **Building Committee:**

- Foundations have been completed and backfilled.
- The roof over the gym mezzanine has been replaced and completed.
- The new concrete block fire wall and elevator shaft are nearly complete.
- Site utilities including a new water main and sanitary sewer line have been started east of the gym.

## Upcoming next 30 days:

- Under slab plumbing will be completed.
- Finish grading for concrete slab will then be completed.
- The first floor concrete slab will be poured.
- After the slab is poured, the steel structure erection will begin.
- Site utility connections on Washington Street will be completed.

## **Finance Committee:**

- Loan application is in process with LCEF.
- \$850,000 in promissory notes have been secured to-date.
