Sixth grade religion focuses on the history of the Bible through the use of the Christ Light curriculum by NPH and the Bible. Study includes:

SCIENCE

Earth Science is the focus, using text by Savvas called **Elevate Science**. Topics covered include:

LANGUAGE ARTS

In 6th grade, our literature, vocabulary, writing, and English grammar studies are being taught in a block schedule to allow for integrating the content and skills within subjects. The foundation for reading instruction is based on comprehension strategies which are directly taught, modeled, practiced and assessed through novel units. The novel units are supplemented with related short stories, poetry, and nonfiction texts that build connections to the time period, events presented, or experiences of the characters, enabling students to better understand the perspectives of others. Vocabulary instruction includes the study of Greek and Latin roots, units from the Sadlier Achieve Series, and application in both writing and reading, extending into other content areas as well. Both writing and grammar skills spiral throughout the year, building one another in order to create products that not only demonstrate specific skills, but also reflect development in thought and expression.

MATH

St. Paul teaches **Reveal Math** in 6th grade. There is an online platform that gives students access to online textbooks, lessons, videos and activities. Instruction includes:

- **Problem Solving**
- ♦ Ratios and Rates
- Operations with Multi-Digit Numbers
 - Integers/Rational Numbers ◆ Coordinate Plans
- Algebraic Expressions
- **♦** Measurements
- Statistics & Data Displays ◆ Geometry
